HOW TO CONSIGN!

GENERAL:

1. We accept consignment items on Tuesday and Wednesday by appointment. Other times are available upon request!
2. There is a 50-item consignment limit. This limit allows for variety in the shop. Unless prior arrangements are made with the Store Manager, we ask that you abide by this limit.
3. Nanny's Place Consignment Shop reserves the right to refuse any items for consignment that do not meet our standards for resale to the public.

BASIC CONSIGNMENT RULES:

Any items that are not addressed in the Basic Consignment Rules (below) must be approved by the Store Manager prior to consignment.

WE DO ACCEPT the following items for consignment:

1. We will accept all types of high quality men's, women's & children's clothing (any size). Clothing items must be in excellent condition, in style, freshly laundered or dry-cleaned. If possible, have the clothing on hangers. (Please, no wire hangers!) If hangers are not available, please have them folded in boxes or plastic bins. All clothes should be free of tears, stains, missing buttons, and broken zippers.
2. We accept clean baby furniture and equipment assuming all the parts are present and in good working order. Examples include: baby beds, walkers, saucers, bouncers, car seats, play yards, swings, and strollers.
3. We accept home decor items, including bedding (preferably in zippered garment bags), lamps, pictures, linens, statues, and small furniture. These items must be Clean, Stain Free and without any Tears.
4. We accept good costume and genuine jewelry pieces.
5. We welcome shoes and purses that are in like-new condition.
6. We accept toys and games in good working order that have no missing parts or pieces.
7. We accept "Power Wheels" or other battery-operated riding toys – provided they are clean, and the battery chargers are included.
8. We accept current video game systems and games that are in working order and the controllers are included.
9. We accept small kitchen appliances that are clean and in good working order.
10. We accept other kitchen items that are clean and in good working order and have no missing parts or pieces. Examples include: sets of dishes and glassware.
11. We accept collectable items. Examples include: dolls, Emmett Kelly clowns, and Thomas Kincaid items.
12. We accept handmade crafts. (Note: Consignment fees are negotiable on handmade items.)
13. We do accept furniture of all kinds. IT MUST BE FREE of stains, odors and tears. To include Entertainment Centers, Couches, Loveseats, Chairs, Dining Room, Bedrooms and any other Accent Pieces.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT the following items for consignment:

1. We do not accept stuffed animals of any kind. Please, no exceptions!
(Any stuffed animals left at Nanny's Place will be disposed of without notice to the consignor.)
2. We do not accept computers or computer parts.
3. We do not accept miscellaneous small toys.
(Any miscellaneous small toys left at Nanny's Place will be disposed of without notice to the consignor.)

PRICING:

All pricing is done by the Store Manager. The selling price of consigned items will be progressively reduced until the items are sold. The consignment fee for all items (except Furniture) is 50% of the selling price of the items that have met the conditions of the Basic Consignment Rules (above). Items can remain on consignment for a maximum of 60 days. Consignors will have 10 days to pick up any items that did not sell during the 60-day consignment period. If the unsold items are not picked up within the 10 day period, the items will be donated to local charities or other worthwhile organizations for their use.

Note: It is the Consignor's responsibility to keep up with the dates of their consignment period.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

1. **CHECK**- Consignor payouts for items sold will be made within 10 business days after the 60 days of the consignment period ends. Consignors will receive payment for the commission percentage of the final sales price of each item sold. It is the consignor's responsibility to pick up their payment within 10 days after the consignment period ends. Payment that are not picked up within 10 days of the end of the consignment period become the property of Nanny's Place Consignment Shop for services rendered.
2. **STORE CREDIT BALANCE**- In lieu of a payment, you may use the proceeds from your sales that have accumulated in your store credit balance to make purchases at Nanny's Place. If you choose this payment option, you must use the store credit balance for a purchase at least once every 30 days to keep your account active. Otherwise, your store credit balance becomes the property of Nanny's Place Consignment Shop for services rendered.
3. Ongoing accounts (where the Consignor periodically submits items for consignment) will be paid every 30 days for the items sold after the initial 60 day consignment period.
4. Note: It is the Consignor's responsibility to keep up with the dates of their consignment period.

ACCOUNT FEES:

1. There is a one-time set up fee (\$4.95) on each new account.
2. For all ongoing accounts, there will be a \$4.95 quarterly account maintenance fee.

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS:

1. Please, understand that Nanny's Place is a resale shop -- not a charity store. These are your customers too, and they expect high quality items.
2. Nanny's Place Consignment Shop is not responsible for lost or damaged items, for any reason.

Please note:

- a. Clothing items that are brought in out of season, stained, missing buttons or otherwise unsellable will be put in the "free" bin at Nanny's Place and provided to local charities without notice to the consignor -- and without compensation.
- b. "In style" refers to clothing items that are no more than 2 years old.
- c. Types of clothing include both casual and formal wear.
- d. We will accept fall and winter clothing during the period of August 1 through January 15. We will accept spring and summer clothing during the period of March 1 through June 15.
- e. We do not accept consignment **Clothing Items** during the months of **February** and **July**. All others items are accepted year round.
